- # Ensure you have a current fishing licence.
- # Emergency radio channel is 16.
- # General chat channel is 69.
- # Drinking, please do so in moderation.
- # Please do not litter the lake. Bring all your rubbish back to base.
- # Please stick to all boating rules and have a very enjoyable day.
- # Any accidents or injury is to be reported to Bruce 0274347714 or John 0210663419.
- # If in trouble on the lake, Bruce 0274347714, John 0210663419
- # To enter a fish, you must be registered to this competition.
- # 1 Fish per individual may be weighed.
- # Please consider catch and release policy.
